Three card poker with 6 card bonus

Game Objective:

Three card poker with 6 card bonus is three games in one, consisting of Ante and Raise, Pair Plus, and 6 Card Bonus wagers. The object in the Ante Raise portion is to get a higher three card hand than the dealer. The Pair Plus wager just concerns if the players three cards contain a pair or better. The 6 card bonus wager combines the players cards and the dealers cards to make the best 5 card poker hand possible. Players may bet on any or all of the games for any amount within the posted table limits. The bets do not have to be of equal value.

Game Rules:

- 1) Players make their wagers for ante, pair plus, and 6 card bonus.
- 2) The dealer gives each player three cards face down, and three cards to themselves. The player may examine their cards.
- 3) If the player made an Ante bet, they must either raise or fold.
- 4) If the player folds, the forfeit their ante wager, but are still active for the pair plus and 6 card wager.
- 5) If a player raises, they must make a bet equal to their ante in the designated betting spot.
- 6) When all ante/raise bets are placed, and folded hands bets are cleared from the board, the dealer will expose their cards. The dealer needs a Queen high the qualify as "playing" for the betting round.
- 7). Working right to left, the dealer will expose the players cards. If the dealer does not qualify, the player will win even money on the Ante bet, and the play bet will push.
- 8) If the dealer does qualify, the dealer will compare their hand against each active players hand in turn. If the players hand is higher, the Ante and Play bets will both receive even money. If the dealers hand is higher, the player will lose both bets.
- 9) If the two hands tie through all three cards, the ante and play bets will push.
- 10) If the player has a straight or higher, they will receive a bonus payout, regardless of the dealers hand or if they win.
- 11) The dealer will analyses each players hand for a pair plus payout, and satisfy the hand according to the below pay table.
- 12) If the player made a 6 card bonus wager, the players and dealers hands are combined to make the best 5 card poker hand they can make. The player will be paid according to the below pay table, if their hand attains a high enough rank.
