## THREE CARD POKER TABLE GAME

Three card poker is played with two independent bets: Pair Plus and Play. A player can make wagers, of at least the posted table minimum and up to the maximum allowed by the state, currently \$10, on either or both of these bets. Additionally, players may make wagers on the 6 Card Bonus bet, of at least \$5 and up to the maximum allowed by the state, currently \$10. Cards are then dealt from a standard 52-card deck, with both player and dealer dealt three cards for their hand. Hands are ranked from highest to lowest: straight flush, three of a kind, straight, flush, pair, nothing.

## Pair Plus Bet

The result of the Pair Plus bet is determined only by the rank of the player's hand; the dealer's hand is irrelevant. The player wins the bet with a pair or better and loses with nothing. The Pair Plus payouts are as follows:

Player's Hand	<u>Payout</u>
Straight flush	40 to 1
Three of a kind	30 to 1
Straight	6 to 1
Flush	3 to 1
Pair	1 to 1

## Ante and Play

Before cards are dealt the player makes an Ante wager. After being dealt a hand of three cards, the player may either:

- Fold and forfeit the Ante bet;
- 2. Play and make a further wager equal to the Ante bet on the Play spot.

If the player decides to make the Play bet, the dealer's hand is revealed and a showdown occurs. If the dealer has a Queen high or better, the hand is said to qualify. The result of the hand is determined as follows, with the rank of player's hands compared to the dealer's hand, as the dealer qualifies:

Result	Ante bet pays	Play bet pays
Dealer does not qualify	1:1	Push
Dealer qualifies, player wins	1:1	1:1
Dealer qualifies, player ties	Push	Push
Dealer qualifies, player loses	Lose	Lose

If the player's hand consists of a straight or better, a bonus is paid on the Ante bet, independent of the dealer's hand or whether the player wins or loses. The Bonus payout are as follows:

Player's Hand	Bonus Payout
Straight flush	4 to 1
Three of a Kind	3 to 1
Straight	1 to 1

## 6 Card Bonus Bet

Before cards are deaft, the player may place a wager on the 6 Card Bonus bet spot. After the Pair Plus and Ante / Play outcomes are determined, the dealer will identify winners and losers of the 6 Card Bonus for those player who placed a 6 Card Bonus bet. To determine winners and losers to the 6 Card Bonus, the dealer will combine his 3 cards with the player's 3 cards. If the player has a winning hand, as shown on the pay table below, the player will be paid. If the player has a losing hand, the dealer will take the player's 6 Card Bonus bet.

6 Card Bonus Hand	Bonus Payout
Royal flush	1,000 to 1
Straight flush	200 to 1
Four of a kind	50 to 1
Full house	25 to 1
Flush	15 to 1
Straight	10 to 1
Three of a kind	5 to 1
