### Three Card Poker with 6 Card Bonus

### Game Objective:

Three Card Poker with 6 Card Bonus is three games consisting of the Ante and Raise, Pair Plus, and 6 Card Bonus. The object in the Ante and raise portion is to receive a higher 3-Card Poker hand than the Dealer. The object of the Pair Plus game is simply to bet on whether you will receive a 3-Card Poker hand with any pair or better. The object of the 6 Card Bonus is to use both the Dealer and Player hands and make the best 5 card poker hand possible. The Player may bet on either or all of the games for any amount within the posted table limit. The bets do not have to be equal amounts.

#### Game Rules:

- 1. Player makes an Ante and/or Pair Plus and/or 6 Card Bonus bet
- 2. The dealer gives each player three cards and himself three cards. The player may examine his own cards. The dealer's cards are dealt face down.
- 3. If the player made the Ante bet, then he must either fold or raise.
- 4. If the player folds, then he forfeits his Ante wager, but not the Pair Plus or 6 Card Bonus wager.
- 5. If the player raises, then he must make an additional Play bet, equal exactly to his Ante bet.
- 6. The dealer will turn his cards over. The dealer needs a queen high or better to qualify.
- 7. If the dealer does not qualify then the player will win even money on the Ante bet and the Play bet will push.
- 8. If the dealer qualifies, then the player's hand will be compared to the dealer's hand, the higher hand wins.
- 9. If the player has the higher poker hand then the Ante and Play bet will both pay even money.
- 10. If the dealer has the higher poker hand then the Ante and Play will both lose.
- 11. If the player and dealer tie then the Ante and Play bets will push.
- 12. If the player made the Ante bet and has a straight or higher then the player will receive an Ante Bonus, regardless of the value of the dealer's hand. Ante Bonus payouts are attached.
- 13. If the player has made the Pair Plus wager and their hand contains a pair or better the player wins the Pair Plus wager, regardless of the dealer's hand. Pair Plus payouts are attached.
- 14. If the player has made the 6 Card Bonus wager the dealer hand and player hand is compared and the best 5 card poker hand is established. If the player's hand qualifies for payouts, the player is paid according to the posted pay table attached. If it does not qualify the player will forfeit that wager.
