THREE CARD POKER

The Minimum wage for Three Card Poker is \$1.00 and the maximum wager is \$10.00.

Three Card Poker involves two independent bets: Pair Plus and Ante and Play. A player may make a wager on either one or both bets before the deal commences. Cards are dealt from a standard 52 card deck and hands are ranked from highest to lowest: Straight Flush, Three of a Kind, Straight, Flush, Pair, Nothing. Both the player and dealer are dealt three cards to their hand. The pair plus is only based on the players 3 cards. Than ante play is based on the dealer's 3 cards against the players 3 cards. The dealer must qualify with a queen high better.

Pair Plus

The result of the Pair Plus bet is determined only by the hand rank of the player's hand, the dealer's hand being irrelevant. The player wins the bet with a pair or better and loses with nothing. A typical pay table is as follows:

Hand Payout

Pair	1 to 1
Flush	3 to 1
Straight	5 to 1
Three of a kind	25 to 1
Straight Flush	30 to 1

After the player receives cards there are two options:

Fold and lose the ante bet.

Play and make a further wager equal to the ante bet.

If the player decides to make the Play bet the dealer's hand is revealed and a showdown:

<u>Result</u>	<u>Ante bet pays</u>	<u>Play bet pays</u>
Dealer does not qualify	win even money	push
dealer qualifies, player's hand wins	win even money	win even money
Dealer qualifies, player's hand ties	Push	push
Dealer qualifies, player's hand loses	Lose	lose

If the player hand consists of a straight or better a bonus is paid on the Ante bet not depending on the dealer's hand or whether the player wins or loses. The bonus pay outs are reflected below:

Straight **1 to 1**

Three of Kind **3 to 1**

Straight Flush **4 to 1**
