Crazy 4 Poker with Queens Up Bonus Bet

Object of the game: Crazy 4 Poker is another variation of poker where the player plays his or her hand against the dealer. The game utilizes four out of five cards to make a poker hand.

Rules of the game: Three initial bets are available to the player. The "Ante" and "Super Bonus" are mandatory while the 'Queens Up' bet is optional. Once the initial bets are placed, the players and dealer each receive five cards. If the player does choose to play, they must place a Play wager equal to the "Ante". If the player has a pair of Aces or higher, they may choose to play three times their "Ante"

The dealer's hand must be King high or better to qualify. Therefore, if the dealer doesn't qualify the "PLAY" wager wins 1 to 1 and the "ANTE" wager pushes. If the player beats dealer's qualifying hand both Play and Ante wagers win 1 to 1. If the player loses to dealer's qualifying hand both "PLAY" and "ANTE" wagers lose. If the player ties dealers qualifying hand both "PLAY" and "ANTE" wagers push.

Since only four cards are used to make poker hands, a four-card straight is a straight; a four-card flush is a flush; and a four-card straight flush is a straight flush. Hands are ranked from highest to lowest as follows:

FOUR OF A KIND

STRAIGHTFLUSH (four suited and sequential cards)

THREE OF A KIND

FLUSH (four suited cards)

STRAIGHT (four sequential cards)

TWO PAIR

PAIR

HIGH CARD

Note: Ace is high except in 4-3-2-Ace sequence.

Equipment Used: 2 standard 52 count playing card decks (used one at a time), cut card, Felted Crazy 4 gaming table, Gaming currency

Method of Play: Once a Crazy 4 game has opened, Dealers are to verify that all cards in both decks are accounted for. Dealers then wash both decks individually and enter into proper shuffle procedure. Shuffling machines may be used. In the event of a manual shuffle the procedure is as follows, Mini wash, Riffle, box, riffle, strip (10-15 times), riffle, box, riffle, one hand cut.

Once players finish placing their bets (Ante, Super Bonus, and Queens Up), the dealer will begin to deal to all active bets and themselves, from left to right one card at a time until all players and the dealer have 5 cards each. The dealer will then place remaining cards or "stub" into the discard rack and starting from the center of the table and working outward with both hands pass out the hands to the players.

Players now look at their hands to determine if they wish to play they're hand by placing the Play bet according to the rules above or folding. Once the round of betting is complete the dealer will then reveal

their hand and one at a time from right to left determine if a player has won, lost or drawn using the rules above and either collect losing bets or pay out winning bets using proper house procedure and attached pay tables.

Types of Wagers:

Ante- Is a mandatory bet to play the game and facilitates heads to head play against the dealer. Pays 1 to 1 when won.

Super Bonus- Like the Ante bet, the Super Bonus bet facilitates play against the dealer. Its wager MUST be equal to the Ante wager. The Super Bonus wins when the player gets a straight or better. However, failure to get at least a straight does not result in an automatic loss of the Super Bonus. This bet pushes when the player gets less than a straight but beats or ties the dealer. Hands of straight or better always receive Super Bonus payouts. When the player has a straight or better but loses to the dealer's qualifying hand, he still receives Super Bonus payouts and the original wager stays on the layout.

Queens Up Bonus- While the Ante and Super Bonus wagers are mandatory, the Queens Up bet is optional. However, players may make the Queens Up wager for any amount within the posted table limits. Players may bet more on the Queens Up bet than they bet on the Ante and Super Bonus.

The Queens Up bonus bet wins when the player receives a pair of Queens or better. Odds are printed on layout. The bet loses when the player fails to get at least a pair of Queens.

Play- The Play wager also facilitates play against the dealer and must be equal to the Ante wager unless a player has a pair of Aces or better in which they can triple down their Bet. The Play wager wins 1 to 1

In accordance with state laws, the minimum wager on Mississippi Stud is \$2.00 / the maximum is \$10.00
