Game Objective:

The object of the game is for the player to achieve a 2-card total of 17 or better. Hand totals of 16 or less will lose. Table layout will include an ante wager for 3 separate hands each having a match the dealer bonus and double down option. Players will also have the option to place a "field" bet.

Game Rules:

1. Flop 22 will be played with one 52-card deck. Cards will be washed appropriately at the initial opening of the table.
2. Each player shall place an ante wager of no more than \$10 in one, two or three hands as indicated on the table layout. It is not necessary to play all 3 hands, however, hands must be played in sequential order meaning that in order to play hand 2, hand 1 must be played and in order to play hand 3, both hands 1 and 2 must be played.
3. Optionally, a player may place a "field" wager of no more than \$10 on the appropriate field bonus line.
4. Ante and Field Bets MUST be placed before any cards are dealt. Players will not be allowed to add hands after any deal card is shown.
5. Aces will be counted as 11, picture cards, 10 and all other cards will be counted at face value.
6. Once Ante and Field bets are placed, the dealer will deal each player 1 card face up and then deal himself 3 cards face down starting with hand 1, then 2 and finally 3. Dealer will then place unused cards in table discard rack.
7. Players field bets will be assessed and paid as outlined or collected prior to proceeding.
 - a. Field Bets: Bets are paid if the players card is a 2, 3, 4, 5 or 6

3, 4 and 5	1:1
2 and 6	2:1

Bets are collected for all other card values
8. Players are then offered, with motions similar to blackjack insurance) to place a bet on the Match Bonus or Double Down Bonus for Hand 1. Player may elect to place a bet, equal to the ante, on the Match circle and/or the Double Down circle corresponding to the hand being played. These bets may ONLY be placed if there is an ANTE bet for that hand.
9. Dealers will allow time for players to place the bonus bets and then motion the close of that option by sweeping their hands in the air across the field of play from right to left.
10. Dealer reveals flop card for Hand being played (1, 2 or 3)
11. Dealer, starting from the right, will reconcile all winning/losing hands and pay according to the pay scale as indicated on the table layout.
 - a. If dealers flop exactly matches players card, match will be paid 1:1
 - b. If dealers flop card does not match players card, match bet will be collected.
 - c. If dealers flop and players card add to 17 or more, ante and double down bets will be paid 1:1
 - d. If dealers flop and players card add to 16 or less, ante and double down bets will be collected

Once the hand is completely reconciled, dealer will place the flop card for the completed hand in the discard rack

Additional Rules/Guidelines:

Opening Table: When a player sits at a table that has not previously been used that day, the dealer will inspect the deck of cards to make sure that the full deck is present. This Dealer will thoroughly “wash” the cards face down on the table for a minimum of 2 minutes ensuring that the cards are being adequately mixed.

If any player or the dealer is dealt an incorrect number of cards, all hands shall be void.
