

## Let It Ride with Pair Plus and 6 Card Bonus

### **The name of the card game:**

Let It Ride with Pair Plus, and 6 Card Bonus

### **The object of the card game:**

Let It Ride is three games consisting of three wagers (1, 2, \$), Pair Plus, and 6 Card Bonus. The object of the three Let It Ride wagers is to compile the highest 5 card poker hand (containing at least a pair of 10's) from three dealt cards and two community cards while keeping the maximum bet on the table. The object of the Pair Plus game is simply to bet on whether you will receive a 3-Card Poker hand with any pair or better. The object of the 6 Card Bonus is to use both the Dealer and Player hands and make the best 5 card poker hand possible, 3 of a Kind or better.

### **The rules of the card game:**

Let It Ride is a game in which players do not compete against other players or the dealer, but rather a pay table in an attempt to build the best 5 card poker hand possible using 3 cards dealt to a player and 2 communal cards.

Let It Ride has three bets not including the Pair Plus and 6 Card Bonus. The circles marked "1" and "2" are optional but if played must be equal to the circle marked "\$". The bonus bets cannot exceed the bet on the circle marked "\$", and the circle marked "\$" must be played to play either bonus bet.

In order to play the Pair Plus and 6 Card Bonus, players must play Let It Ride.

If playing all the available bets on Let It Ride, players make two decisions about whether to take their bets back, or "Let It Ride" and leave their bets out before each of the communal cards are flipped. Players cannot move these chips directly once bet, but rather should signal to the dealer their intention for the bet.

Let It Ride allows players to handle cards, however they must stay above the table at all time, failure to do so will lead to immediate reprimand by the dealers. Players are not allowed to show their cards to other players prior to the end of betting action (Let It Ride – Method of Play: Step 4). Players will be warned by the dealer if either of these infractions are broken with escalation to the floor manager if either of these behaviors persist. This rule is not enforced if players opt to have their cards dealt face-up due to COVID-19 safety concerns.

### **The equipment used for the card game:**

- Standard gaming table including a chip well and a cash drop box and plastic mallet
- Let It Ride felt with locations for Pair Plus and 6 Card Bonus wager
- Two separate distinguished decks of 52 cards and a cut card
- Gaming chips
- Discard rack

### **The method of play for the card game:**

1. Player makes a Let it Ride and/or Pair Plus and/or 6 Card Bonus bet. Player makes three equal bets in the three circles marked “1”, “2”, and ”\$” right to left. The dealer makes three passes from left to right, dealing three cards to each player and three community cards to themselves, face down (second dealer card is 6 Card Bonus bet card).
2. After the player looks at their three cards, they may withdraw their bet in Circle 1 by signaling the dealer to push it back to them, or they can “Let it Ride” and stay in play. Once the player chooses to let a bet ride it must stay on the table until the end of the hand. Likewise, when a bet is withdrawn, it stays out of play.
3. The dealer then turns the first of his or her two cards face up. The player can now withdraw their Circle 2 bet back or they can let it ride. Their Circle 1 decision does not restrict their Circle 2 option in any way. After the player makes their Circle 2 choice the betting is over because the \$ Circle bet always stays in play.
4. The dealer then completes all players’ hands by turning their second card face up.
5. At this final stage, if the combined five card hand does not give the player a pair of tens or better, the dealer collects the \$ Circle bets and any others that the players let ride. If any of the players have a pair of tens or better, the dealer pays the \$ Circle bet and any others left in play, in accordance with the payout table attached.
6. If the player has made the Pair Plus wager and their hand contains a pair or better the player wins the Pair Plus wager, regardless of the dealer’s hand. Pair Plus payouts can be found in Let It Ride Payout Table 2: Pair Plus.
7. If the player has made the 6 Card Bonus wager the dealer reveals the middle card and the player’s hand is evaluated with the three communal cards and the best 5 card poker hand is established. If the player’s hand qualifies for payouts, the player is paid according to Let It Ride Pay Table 3: 6 Card Bonus. If it does not qualify the player will forfeit that wager.

### **Types of Wager:**

- Let It Ride Wagers (Circles Marked “1”, “2” and “\$”)
  - Pays According to Let It Ride Pay Table 1
- Pair Plus
  - Pays According to Let It Ride Pay Table 2
- 6 Card Bonus
  - Pays According to Let It Ride Pay Table 3

### **Wager Amounts:**

- Let it Ride Wagers (1, 2, \$): \$2 - \$10
  - Wagers on Circles marked “1” or “2” must be equal in cash value to wager placed on “\$”
- Pair Plus: \$1 - \$10
  - Bonus bet cannot exceed the player’s Circle marked “\$” wager
- 6 Card Bonus: \$1 - \$10
  - Bonus bet cannot exceed the player’s Circle marked “\$” wager

**The payouts and payout odds for each wager in the card game:**

**Let It Ride Payout Table 1**
