Money Wheel

The name of the game: Money Wheel (also known as Big 6)

The object of the game:

Players place bets on the betting space which matches the location of the marker on the wheel at the end of the spin.

The rules of the game:

Players may not place bets once the dealer has spun the wheel or announced “No More Bets”.

Players may never touch the wheel.

The equipment of the game:

- Money Wheel with clapper
- Betting Table with betting spaces for each bet available on the wheel
- A locked cash box and paddle
- Cash value chips

The method of play of the game:

Making Bets

1. To bet, the player places a wager, within the table minimum (\$1) and maximum (\$10), on one or more of the betting spots. Bets are paid if the clapper comes to rest in a partition having the same number or symbol as the betting spots selected by the player and are paid as described in Money Wheel Pay Table 1 below.

Taking and Paying

1. The dealer announces the winning number in a loud and clear voice and proceeds to sweep/take all losing bets.
2. The dealer pays winning bets according to Money Wheel Pay Table 1.
3. The dealer **PLUCKS** the layout below the winning number from **front to back and outside in** beginning with the 1 to 1 bets and work their way towards the 40 to 1 bets.
4. The dealer sweeps losing wagers above the winning number towards the center of the table into the dealer’s work area. The dealer must be extremely careful not to sweep away any winning wagers when they clear the layout.
5. The dealer leaves all losing wagers in the dealer’s work area in front of the bank rack until all winning wagers are paid out.
6. The dealer determines the amounts on all winning bets and cuts payouts for that winning number in the dealer’s work area.
7. The dealer then stacks the payoffs and places them next to the winning bets working from the outside in.
8. The dealer must receive approval from the floor manager for \$100 payoffs or higher.

9. A player is prohibited from placing new wagers before the dealer clears losing wagers and pays all winning wagers.

Spinning the Money Wheel

1. Before the spin of the wheel, the dealer announces "No More Bets".
2. The dealer spins the wheel, in either direction, such that the wheel completes a valid spin of at least three revolutions. When the wheel has to come to a rest, the dealer announces the symbol or number of the partition the clapper is in as the winner.
3. If the wheel fails to complete three revolutions, the dealer announces "No Spin" and re-spins the wheel.
4. If the clapper has come to a rest on a peg between partitions, the dealer announces "No Spin" and re-spins the wheel.

Game Protection Notes

1. The dealer may not, at any time while the wheel is in motion, take their eyes off the layout. The River Cardroom may use a mirror in this instance so that the dealer does not need to turn his eyes away from the layout. A second dealer may be used to eliminate this motion.
2. The dealer must receive approval from the floor manager whenever payouts over \$100 are won and green chips (\$25) are paid out.
3. The dealer must notify the floor manager of any unclaimed winning bet left on the layout.

The types of wager or wagers for the game:

One: Betting space designated by image of a One Dollar U.S. Federal Reserve Note

Two: Betting space designated by image of a Two Dollar U.S. Federal Reserve Note

Five: Betting space designated by image of a Five Dollar U.S. Federal Reserve Note

Ten: Betting space designated by image of a Ten Dollar U.S. Federal Reserve Note

Twenty: Betting space designated by image of a Twenty Dollar U.S. Federal Reserve Note

Joker: Betting space designated by image of a Joker

American Flag: Betting space designated by image of an American Flag

The wager amounts for the game:

One: \$1 - \$10

Two: \$1 - \$10

Five: \$1 - \$10

Ten: \$1 - \$10

Twenty: \$1 - \$10

Joker: \$1 - \$10

American Flag: \$1 - \$10

The payouts and payout odds of each wager in the game:
