

Packs Poker
Rules of Play
Updated 2021.02.27

Game Objective:

The object of the game is for the player to achieve a higher 5-card poker hand than the dealer, according to standard rules of poker, by combining their hand with the 2-card community “packs” for which the player has made a wager.

Game Rules:

1. Pack's Poker will be played with one 52-card deck.
2. Each player shall place a wager in one or more of the Pack's betting circles. Optionally, a player may place one or more bonus wagers in any bonus spot correlating to their pack's bet. Bonus wagers may not be placed unless there is a corresponding pack's hand wager. All pack's bets be a minimum of \$2 to a maximum of \$10. Bonus bets can range from \$1 to \$10.
3. All bets must be placed prior to any cards being dealt.
4. To begin, the dealer will place 1 card in each community hand space on the layout, repeating the process once resulting in a 2-card pile on each space.
5. 5 cards will then be dealt, one at a time, face-down, to each of the players and the dealer. Card will be dealt left to right ending with the dealer.
6. Once all cards have been dealt, players will view their cards. The dealer will reveal the 1st pack of community cards by turning them face up in the appropriate space on the layout.
7. Starting to the dealer's right, each hand will be reviewed and compared to the dealers hand to determine who has the best 5-card hand.
8. Winning bonus hands (3 of a kind or better) will be settled according to the payout table on the layout – only the highest hand will be paid.
9. Bonus payouts will be paid regardless of dealer's hand.
10. Winning pack's hands will be paid 1 to 1.
11. When the dealer's hand beats the players hand, the dealer will collect the packs bet.
12. When the dealer's hand and the players hand are tie, the bonus wager will be collected and the pack's bet will be considered a push.
13. When a player wins with “high card” (no pair or better), the bonus wager will be collected and the pack's bet will be considered a push.
14. When the dealer wins with “high card”, both the bonus wager and the pack's bet will be collected and placed in the chip tray.
15. The process is repeated with each player until all packs are settled.

Additional Rules/Guidelines:

Opening Table: When a player sits at a table that has not previously been used that day, the dealer will inspect the deck of cards to make sure that the full deck is present. This Dealer will thoroughly “wash” the cards face down on the table for a minimum of 2 minutes ensuring that the cards are being adequately mixed.

If any player or the dealer is dealt an incorrect number of cards, all hands shall be void.

If the dealer is dealt 4 cards of the 5-card hand, the dealer shall deal an additional card to complete the hand. And other misdeal to the dealer shall result in all hands being void and the cards shall be reshuffled.

Bonus Pay Table

5-card Royal Flush	200 to 1
Straight Flush	100 to 1
4 of a Kind	40 to 1
Full House	10 to 1
Flush	4 to 1
Straight	3 to 1
3 of a Kind	2 to 1
