Roulette

Object of the game:

Players place chips, betting which of thirty eight divided sections in a roulette wheel the ball will drop into.

Rules of the game:

Players purchase chips from the dealer. Each player will be assigned a different color chip. If there are no different colored chips available, the game is full. Players cannot bet with CBK cash chips on table.

Each chip represents one dollar, unless clearly marked otherwise. In rare circumstances, a player can request default four dollar chips. The manager will place a four dollar cash chip on top of that player's designated color, each dealer will be informed before they start working the table of the players betting limitations.

Players must be at the table to place bets, verbal declarations of bets are not binding, unlike in cash games

Players are free to cash out whenever they want, but must cash out all their chips at the same time. A player informs the dealer they wish to cash out, the dealer counts down their chips and announces the cash out to the cashier who completes the transaction.

Equipment to be used:

A roulette wheel and ball will be kept at the table along with six different collared sets of chips.

Roulette Method of play:

People place bets on what number they think will come up by lying down chips on the table; the precise location of the chips indicates the bet being made. Bets can be placed in a manner that covers single numbers, two numbers, three numbers, four numbers, five numbers, six numbers, twelve numbers (one third of the wheel, discounting 0-00) and eighteen numbers (half the wheel, discounting 0-00)

Once the dealer judges that all bets are about done being placed, the dealer will spin the wheel in one direction, and spin the ball in the other. The dealer will then allow a brief period to the players to place final bets, or adjust the bets they have already placed

before announcing "No More Bets" and waving a hand across the table. Any bets on the table are now frozen, and any additional bets a player attempts to put down are returned to the player.

When the ball lands, the dealer marks the number it lands in, clears all losing bet from the table and pays off winning bets. The dealer then removes the marker from the winning number. Once the marker is removed, players are free to place new bets, and the process is repeated.

Types of Wagers for the game/Wager amount for the game:

Players are free to wager anywhere from \$1 - \$10 dollar per bet. Each individual bet is limited to a four dollar increment. There is no limit, other than the maximum amount of bets available on a roulette table, to the number of four dollar bets that can be places.

Payout and Payout odds:

Payouts are incremental based on the number of numbers covered by the winning bet.

1 number pays 30-1

2 numbers pay 14-1

3 numbers pay 10-1

4 numbers pay 7-1

5 numbers pay 5-1

6 numbers pay 4-1

12 numbers pay 2-1

18 numbers pay 1-1

House Rules Applicable to All Games:

No swearing at or berating other people at the table.
