

Roulette

Objective of the game:

Players place chips, betting which of 38 divided sections in a roulette wheel a spun ball will drop into.

Rules of the game:

Players purchase chips from the dealer. Each player will be assigned a different color chip. One player only will be allowed to bet \$5 cash chips only on any given spin. Once each color chip at the table is assigned to a player, the table is full.

Each chip represents one dollar, unless clearly marked otherwise. Players can request \$2, \$5 or \$10 chips. In such a case, one chip of that players color will be placed on the rim of the wheel with a \$2 \$5 or \$10 marker placed on top of it. Upon exiting a table, dealers will make their replacements aware of which players are using higher denomination chips.

Players must be at the table to place their bets.

Verbal declarations of bets are not binding.

Players are free to cash out whenever they want. A player will inform the dealer that they wish to cash out, the dealer will count down the players stack, making it clear from our camera's vantage point how many chips are present. They will then color the player up into cash chips.

Equipment to be used:

A roulette wheel and ball.

Five sets of chips in different colors.

A starting bank of chips.

Method of play:

Players will place bets on numbers, colors, and sections that are represented on the roulette table.

When players are mostly done placing bets, the dealer will spin the ball counter to the direction that the wheel is spinning. The dealer will wait a brief period for last second bets then announce "No more bets" to the table, while sweeping their hand above the betting area. Bets that have been placed are now frozen. No additional betting is permitted.

When the ball lands, the dealer marks the number it lands in, clears losing bets, and pays off winning bets. The dealer then removes the marker, and the process is repeated.

Types of wagers / wager amounts:

Players are free to wager anywhere from \$1-\$10 dollars per bet. Each individual bet is limited to a \$10 increment. The player may place as many \$10 bets as they want, within the common limits of Roulette play. No single wager can be greater than \$10.

Payouts and payout odds:

Payouts are incremental based on the number of numbers covered by the bet.

1 number pays 35:1

2 numbers, 17:1

3 numbers, 11:1

4 numbers, 8:1

5 numbers, 6:1

6 numbers, 5:1

12 numbers, 2:1

18 numbers, 1:1

House Rules applicable to all games:

All standard table games rules will be applicable to this game.

No swearing at or berating dealers or other players.
