## INSTRUCTIONS FOR SUBMITTING A COMMERCIAL BINGO HALL APPLICATION

### A. Submit the Application

Submit the completed application, all required documentation and the licensing fee to:

**New Hampshire Lottery Commission, 14 Integra Drive, Concord, NH 03301**

Applications must be received at least 72 hours prior to any bingo event being held at the hall.

### B. Call If There Are Any Questions

### C. Keep All Information Up-To-Date

If any of the information provided on or with the application changes or is found to be inaccurate, the applicant must submit updated or corrected information to the NH Lottery Commission within 10 days of the event that resulted in the change, or discovery of the inaccuracy.
