### Legislation to Watch

SB316 - Relative to Lucky 7 Licenses

This bill would authorize charitable organizations to sell Lucky 7 tickets at a facility licensed to conduct games of chance. A public hearing before the House Ways & Means Committee is scheduled for April 5, 2022 at 10:00am at the Legislative Office Building in Concord.

SB318 - Extending the hours in which Games of Chance may be conducted. Currently, games of chance facilities can operate between the hours of 11am and 1am the following day. This bill would extend hours of operation to be between the hours of 8am and 4am the following day. A public hearing before the House Ways & Means Committee is scheduled for April 5, 2022 at 10:30am at the Legislative Office Building in Concord.

## History of Bingo

BACKGROUND RESULTS BEFORE LICENSURE

Just a friendly reminder that all Games of Chance applications must be submitted to the Licensing Unit at least 60-days in advance. This 60-day window allows State Police enough time to process the applicant's criminal background check. It is highly recommended that applicants schedule their appointments and complete their fingerprinting PRIOR to submitting their applications. We cannot issue any Games of Chance licenses until we have received the corresponding criminal background results.

## Surveillance Requirements

Game operators offering Games of Chance must comply with the surveillance requirements of Lot 7207.06. Additional surveillance requirements for those offering Historic Horse Racing (HHR) can be found in Lot 8205.

In accordance with Lot 7207.06(a), surveillance of the gaming area shall comply with the following:

- (1) A game operator employer conducting games of chance at a facility that is required to be licensed pursuant to RSA 287-D:7 shall conduct and record at the expense of the game operator employer;
- (2) Surveillance shall:
  - a. Include the customer, the employee, the game floor, and the surrounding area; and
  - b. Monitor and record with sufficient clarity to identify employees and customers in all areas where currency is counted, verified, sorted, stacked, or stored, including monitoring and recording all table game drop boxes, safes, and counting surfaces, and all cashier personnel;
- (3) Video surveillance shall:
  - a. Allow for the clear, unobstructed views of cashier transactions, table games where cash wagers are accepted, and the counting of money from storage boxes removed from a gaming table;
  - b. Be of sufficient clarity to identify:
    1. Employees and customers;
    2. Table numbers;
    3. Cash denominations;
    4. Card values, including pips, face cards, and suits;
    5. Chip values, and where applicable, the number of chips in a rack; and
    6. Game outcomes; and
  - c. Be recorded in color;
- (4) The counting surface area shall be continuously monitored and recorded by a dedicated camera during the count;
- (5) Access to the surveillance equipment shall be limited to management personnel, designated employees, state regulators, and other persons authorized in accordance with the surveillance policy;
- (6) The game operator employer shall ensure at least one person at the facility while games of chance are being conducted is trained in the use of the equipment, knowledge of the games, and all applicable regulations;
- (7) Each camera required by these rules shall be installed in a manner that will prevent it from being readily obstructed, tampered with, or disabled by customers or employees;
- (8) Each malfunction of surveillance system equipment required by the standards in this section shall be repaired within 72 hours after the malfunction is discovered, if practicable, provided any such malfunction is reported to the commission immediately; and
- (9) In the event of a dedicated camera malfunction, the game operator employer or the surveillance person shall immediately provide alternative camera coverage or other security measures.

## Importance of Effective Internal Controls

The cash intensive nature of the gaming industry exposes game rooms to an elevated risk of loss. It is not practical to record all table game transactions and most cash and cash equivalents are not recorded until they are removed from drop boxes and counted; consequently, the risk of fraud and theft in gaming operations is greater than in most other industries. Minimizing these risks requires the development of procedures that control the authorization, accountability, and safekeeping of the gaming operations' major asset, cash.

Internal control activities include a range of preventive and/or detective measures that mitigate risks and enable the gaming operation to achieve its objectives. Critical types of controls in gaming operations include documentation controls, physical safeguards, and employee controls.

The application of documentation controls provides recorded evidence that can be tested through the inspection of transaction documents and records. Physical safeguards, such as safes, cashiers' cages and other types of barriers limit access to game room assets. Employee controls represent activities including supervision and accountability for gaming transactions. Employee controls are more difficult to track but are critical in the prevention or detection of fraud and theft. The high frequency of non-documented cash transactions in gaming operations means that employee controls play a larger role than in many other industries. Assurance that these controls are working is critical and can be achieved by regularly monitoring routine operations.

## HHR Reminder

If you are submitting an application for an Historic Horse Racing license, please note, per Lot 8202.02(b)(5), an applicant that is an organization must submit financial statements that have been reviewed or audited by a Certified Public Accountant. The financial statements should include a balance sheet, income statement, cash flow statement and statement of equity or capital.

## Dual Control for Cash and Cash Equivalents

Per Lot 7206.08(d)(1), a GOE is required to establish "Internal controls to secure and count all cash received in connection with a game of chance event, including the requirement that no fewer than two individuals be responsible for counting the receipts;". Lot 7206.08(b)(10) requires that "Functions, duties, and responsibilities are appropriately segregated and performed in accordance with sound practices by authorized personnel, and no individual is in a position to perpetuate fraud or conceal errors or irregularities in the normal course of duties". The following controls apply to both **cash** (e.g. pit game cash drops) and **cash equivalents** (e.g. poker rakes):

- Counts shall be performed by at least two authorized employees each indicating their personal verification. Each employee performing the count shall not have had any involvement in the game(s) for which they are counting.
- Counts shall be performed separately by each employee.
- Counts shall be performed with the 2nd count immediately following the 1st count and shall be uninterrupted.
- Cash and cash value chips shall be immediately secured post verification and mutual agreement on amount.
- Counts shall not rely on surveillance as a mitigating dual control.



## Tier I ("Legacy") Charitable Organizations

Game operators must contract with 2 licensed charitable organizations for each game date that Historic Horse Racing (HHR) will be offered. "Legacy" charities, those organizations that had game dates in **calendar year 2020**, are given preference and entitled to receive 100% of game of chance (GOC) revenue, and 50% of HHR revenue when sharing a game date with a Tier II organization (consisting of any charity that does not otherwise qualify as a Tier I). When both charities assigned to a game date are from the same Tier, then revenue from GOC and HHR are shared equally. Furthermore, beginning January 1, 2024, the Tier system will expire and each charity contracted for a given game date will share equally in GOC and HHR revenue.
