Where to Find a Charity's Lucky 7 License # and Expiration Date

Option #1: At the gaming location.

Charities are required to prominently display their current Lucky 7 license in the immediate area where the tickets will be sold.

Option #2: On the New Hampshire Online Licensing website

This website can be accessed in the following ways:

To find a charity's license:

- 1. Be sure to search for a "business" license.
 - If the top of the web page says "Business Search" you are in the right place.
 - If the top of the web page says "Person Search", click the blue link to "Search for a business license." This will bring you to the "Business Search" page
- 2. Under "Profession", select "Bingo and Lucky 7"
- 3. Under "License Type", select either "Annual Lucky 7 Charity" or "Monthly Lucky 7 Charity".
 - Most fraternal halls have "Annual" license, but a few have "Monthly" licenses.
 - All charities selling Lucky 7 in conjunction with Bingo must have a "Monthly" license.
